Solution: Planking the Walk

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This puzzle was an installation puzzle. Nine posters were distributed among picnic tables. Each poster had three words overlaid on top of the image of a maritime signal flag. The signal flags were the flags that corresponded to the letters A to I. This provides an ordering.

The letters were expanded vertically so that were hard to read normally. However, they were easily readable if looked at the page edge on, such as if you were to plank on the tables. The three words are all members of some group. There exists a member of the NATO phonetic alphabet which would also fit these groupings. (NATO also uses maritime signal flags to indicate these letters). Reading the first letter of the NATO alphabet members give the solution to the puzzle: YOUNG GIRL.
