Using the number of points each nation scored to index into that nation's name, in order of the standings within each group, spells "YOU REQUIRE THE TOPONYM LANDOVER," which is a fancy way of saying that the answer is **LANDOVER**, a toponym (place name) for a location where football is played (the other kind of football – it is the home of the Washington Redskins).

*While "Korea DPR" is FIFA's official name for this nation, using "North Korea" will yield the same letter.
