The number of points required depends on the number of team members you have present at BAPHL today. If your team has one or two people, you'll need 5 points. If your team has three or four people, you'll need 10 points, and if your team has five or six, you'll need 15 points.

The bonus "Bribery" category is present if you wish to convince us to undertake some of the ritual powering instead of doing it yourselves.

- A team member in front of a red-topped parking meter [1]
- A team member swinging on a swing [1]
- A fire escape [1]
- A storefront containing a misspelled English word [1]
- A photo containing at least five instances of the word "Brookline" [1]
- A C line train in motion [1]
- A 66 bus in motion [1]
- A picture containing $N + 1$ smiling people, where N is the number of people on your team [1]
- A photograph containing more than one bank [1, +1 bonus point if you get three or more banks in the same shot]
- A phone booth [1, +1 bonus point if the booth has flowers in it]
- A photograph of a team member camouflaging themselves in front of a mural [1]
- A photograph of something commemorating Brookline's founding [1]
- A team member in front of a sign with the name of a color [1]
- A sign advertising the birthplace of JFK [1, +2 bonus points if the sign is actually at his birthplace]
- A picture containing two instances of the same chain store in the same shot [2]
- A forced-perspective photograph of a team member or members destroying the S.S. Pierce Building [2]

Bribery

- A rhyming poem of at least ten lines proclaiming the virtues of BAPHL [1]
- A cupcake or brownie [2, we reserve the right to eat it]
