



## Five if by Wheelbarrow

Come now and hear of Rose Kennedy's life:

Like many political wives, Rose Fitzgerald Kennedy had to put up with a lot, including her husband's secret and not-so-secret infidelities. In a Rows Garden puzzle, answers go into the grid in two ways: each Row of the garden contains two answers reading from left to right (except for Rows A and L, which each contain one 9-letter answer reading across the nine producing spaces). The Bloom clues are divided into three lists: White, Yellow, and Pink. The 6-letter answer to each clue should be placed in an appropriately-colored hexagon, starting in any space and reading either clockwise or counterclockwise. Bloom clues are sorted alphabetically by answer within each list. It is up to you to determine where each bloom goes by using the Row answers.
