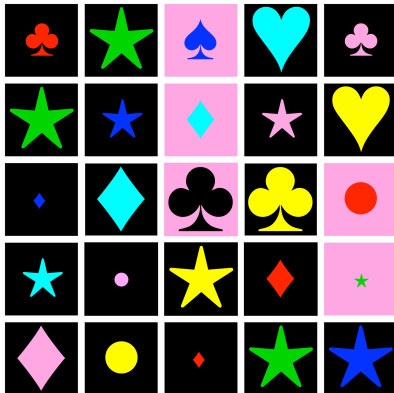


Rose-Colored Glasses

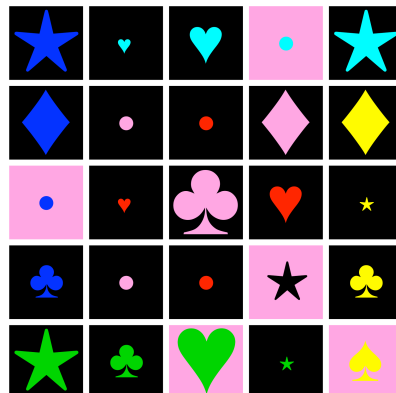

As one might divine from the flavor text, or from following at instructions, the solver can't see the rose-colored objects. This is complicated by the fact that each of the teammates also can't see one of the other five colors. So the solver must do their best to follow their instructions, trying to simultaneously discern what color the teammate can't see and what shapes the solver can't see. Every rose-colored object can be identified by the instructions. Once all the requested objects are removed, there are only five objects (one of each color visible to the teammate) which are visible to the teammate.

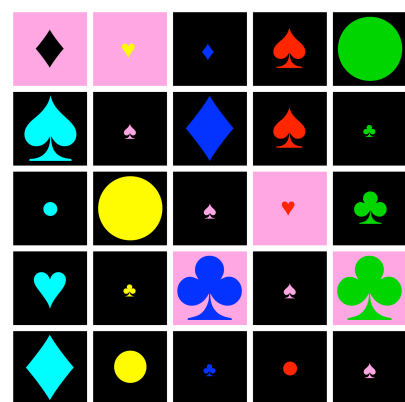
Andrew (Can't See Yellow)



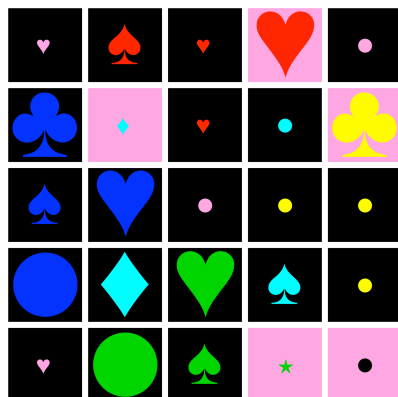
Beatrice (Can't See Red)



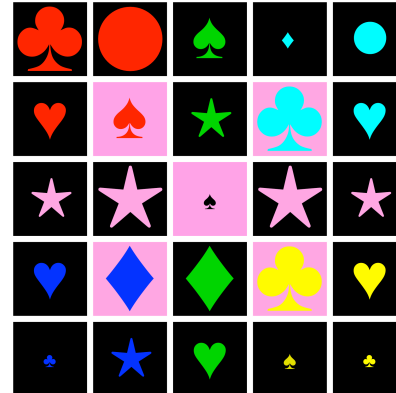
Cynthia (Can't See Cyan)



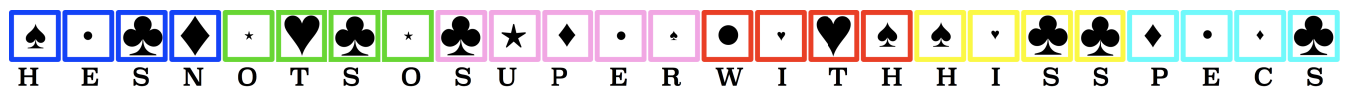
Donald (Can't See Blue)
