



Puzzle No. 001:

Professor Layton and the Guided Tour of the Private Institute (Apprentice)

*A great institution isn't just its buildings; it's the people who work there too. Something's not quite right about this tour guide, though. It seems he's having difficulty reading the plaques on the wall; he keeps getting letters wrong.*

Walk past some vending machines near where you received this puzzle. **A glass plaque commemorates a career of studying people's attitudes and feelings. (3 → 6)**

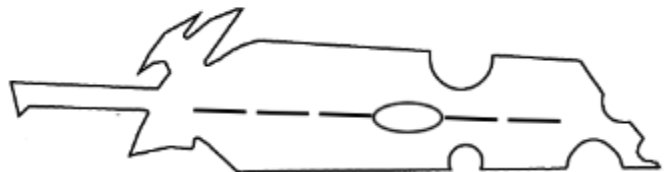
Just up the stairs, another plaque is **hodor hodor hodor hodor hodor hodor. (10 → 1)**

Turn around and find your way to MIT's longest hallway. Halfway down it, there's a lobby with a view of the Boston skyline. **An engraving here honors an old MIT president; apparently these buildings are an adorable dedication to his memory. (12 → 4 9)**

Keep going, but turn left at a staircase before you reach a vaulted ceiling. Walk all the way down this hallway, then proceed to the nearest exit to the outdoors. **The professor honored here taught classes for summoning high winds and rain dancing. Also, his parents were cyborgs? (11 8 → 5 2)**

Cross the courtyard just outside the doors. (It's okay; you can hurry without missing anything.) Once inside, you'll see a plaque for a **joker who funded buildings to arrive at chemistry itself... whatever that means. (7 → 2)**

Walk forward until you see a stairwell and a mural of animals, then turn left. A third of the way to your starting point, you'll be able to use what you've learned to find out what to do next.
