**GENRE:** Musical

**COMPOSER/LYRICIST:** Rodgers and Hammerstein

**ADAPTATION?:** Yes, of the 1959 Stage Musical

**OTHER OSCARS IT WON:** Best Film Editing, Best Sound Recording, Best Music, Best Director

**OTHER OSCARS IT WAS NOMINATED FOR:** Best Actress (Julie Andrews), Best Supporting Actress (Peggy Wood), Best Cinematography, Best Art Direction, Best Costume Design

-Film is in color

-Film was selected for preservation in the National Film Registry in 2001

-Appears on the American Film Institute’s 100 Greatest Films of All Time lists (55 in 1998, 40 in 2008)

**ICONIC LINES:** None

**ICONIC SONGS:** Pretty much all of them

**REMAKES?:** *The Sound of Music Live* in 2013, and the *British Sound of Music Live* in 2015

-Filmed in Hollywood and partially on location in Salzburg

-Takes place in Salzburg, Austria (Europe)

- “Historical” film (set in 1938, released in 1965)

-Famous shot: opening, with Maria spinning on the hills
