PURSUIT

Each of the clues provided are the first word of a two word phrase or saying, sorted alphabetically by second word. In some cases, the clue is reused and yields a pair of phrases.

The set of second words from these phrases can be filled into the drop-cross grid as shown:

In each reused instance, the drop-cross entries intersect. These intersecting letters spell the words DOUBLE and GRIND from top to bottom.

Interpreting these similarly to the intersecting words from the grid above, they can each be preceded by the final answer, **DAILY**.
